OpenItem uses Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) to add an extra layer of security beyond a username and password. By requiring a second verification step - such as a one-time code sent to a mobile device's authenticator app - 2FA ensures that only authorised users can access the platform.

Two-Factor Authentication strengthens security by protecting user accounts even if passwords are compromised, significantly reducing the risk of unauthorised access and fraud. It supports best-practice security and compliance standards while giving users confidence that their information and activities are securely protected at all times.
